



Playing in the Light: Training in Godly Play® and Faith & Play™ for Ouakers

Dear Friends,

November 7-9, we will gather at Centre Friends Meeting for a weekend of stories, worship, fellowship and play together. I look forward to meeting you, and working together during the *Playing in the Light* training!

A few thoughts on being ready for *Playing in the Light*:

- The **schedule of times** for the training is 15 hours, for us to be able to cover what we need. Please plan to be there all three days for the times scheduled; we will check in about our energy and needs throughout, and try to be spacious where we can.
- **Please dress comfortably!** If you would like, bring a pillow or other support for times when we sit on the floor.
- **Please bring pen/pencil**; all other training materials will be provided.
- Snacks and lunches on Saturday and Sunday will be provided by our hosts at Centre Friends Meeting.
- An important part of the training is **sharing of stories**. After individual practice time, you will each present a Godly Play or Faith & Play story to the group. The purpose of this is twofold: for you to experience leading a story, and for the group to hear many stories in the course of the training. The conversation after we hear a story together is a rich part of our work. *You do not need to prepare beforehand*.
- If you're interested in **reading** to "prime the pump" for the training, or if you're looking to learn more afterward, a recommended book is *Teaching Godly Play: How to Mentor the Spiritual Development of Children* by Godly Play founder Jerome Berryman. This is a basic introduction to the Godly Play method, which we use for working with children and Faith & Play stories. It is available from Amazon, and also Quakerbooks of FGC www.quakerbooks.org.
