In 1941, Friends at Kennett Monthly Meeting, then at the State Street Meetinghouse, had a committee responsible for raising money for the American Friends Service Committee, a Nobel-prize winning Quaker-based international peace organization. On 3/28/1941 they put on a turkey dinner and along with bake sale profits made a contribution to the AFSC. In 1943 this committee joined with the Needy Members Committee and the Best Interests Committee and became the Social Services Committee, sponsoring bake sales, dinners and rummage sales for the benefit of AFSC. In 1943 they held a bazaar which years later became to be known as the *Quaker Fair*. For the 70 years since then, Kennett Monthly Meeting has held a family fair raising about \$10,000 annually to benefit the American Friends Service Committee. The times are changing and this year KMM brings back the food portion of the Quaker Fair—now called *Quaker Fare*. We revive our traditional menu, but this year we offer two kinds of our famous Mushroom Soup, and we will have tables with knit-wear for sale, which were always popular at the Fair, as well as our "Country Kitchen" homemade goodies.
