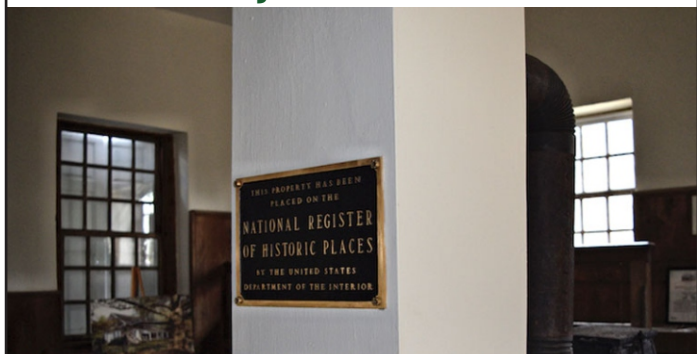

The Chichester Meetinghouse is a well-preserved and unusual example of 18th century Quaker architecture...



Constructed between 1769 and 1771, the fieldstone building replaced an earlier c.1688 log structure that was destroyed by fire. A date-stone in the west gable bears the inscription R+D 1769, attributed to Richard Dutton, a major contributor to Chichester Friends interests'. In 1973, the meetinghouse was added to the National Register of Historic Places.
