- a) Historic Properties Update Several Friends met with Emily Temple Abels and Peter Temple of Larmore Scarlett to discuss process and needs around transfer of property from monthly or quarterly meeting ownership; as a result the committee approved doing a title search on the Colora Meetinghouse property to discover current ownership and restrictions on the property; communications sent to Larmore Scarlett; will go out to WGMM and Steve Balderston, Colora MH trustee
- b) PYM Nominating/Councils coordinator has begun service; minute we sent on seeking practical advice on transfer of property was received and the need affirmed by others; the Admin Council will be taking up the work
- c) 4th month Mill Creek likes their neighboring community to see that our meeting house is alive and welcoming to all.
